RE: The HCA's Quanci Visual Arts Award  
Dear HMHS Seniors –

The Quanci Visual Arts Award is granted to a student who uses artistic expression to thoughtfully and creatively respond to the same writing prompt used for the Bradshaw Literary Award. The student must also include a written description of their thoughts about the piece and how it relates to the prompt.

This year's **2026 Bradshaw Literary Award prompt:**

**250 years ago, the New Jersey Delegates met at the Indian King Tavern in Haddonfield to officially ratify the Declaration of Independence, marking the historic transition from a colony to a sovereign State. As a vital "crossroads" of the American Revolution, Haddonfield played a pivotal role in the birth of our nation—a legacy that continues to shape its modern civic identity as we celebrate America's 250th anniversary.**

**Our nation was founded on the principles of civic engagement and the spirit of self-determination. How has your life in Haddonfield been shaped by that same enduring spirit?**

Here are the details to submit:

- **All submissions due Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026.**
- Artwork should be no larger than 20×30 in the student's choice of medium
- Each submission **MUST INCLUDE A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION** of the student's thought behind the piece including how it relates to the writing prompt. This description should be attached to the back of the artwork.
- Students **MUST** include a phone number for identification and communication purposes – all submissions are evaluated "BLIND."
- Artwork should be delivered to the HMHS Art teacher Mrs. Allie Westerside
- We ask permission to display all the art pieces at the HCA annual Town Dinner on Wednesday, April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026 where the winning student will be recognized.
- The winner will receive a \$500 scholarship on Senior Awards Night
