Here are the details to submit:

- **All submissions due Monday April 4th, 2022.**
- This scholarship is only open to Haddonfield Memorial High School seniors.
- The essay should be in 5 paragraph form and a maximum length of 500 words.
- Students **MUST** include a contact phone number at the top of your essay – submissions will be “blind” – no names.
- Please submit a typed and printed copy of your essay to School Administrator Samantha Wilson at the front office.

Submissions are evaluated by members of the HCA Board of Governors and the winner is asked to present their essay at the HCA annual Town Dinner on April 28th, 2022. The winning student is also presented with a \$500 award scholarship on Senior Awards Night.
